A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE VII, SECTION 1, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Article VII, section 1, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to
4 be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
5 Governor:

6 1. Qualifications for and method of voting; secrecy

7 Section 1. A. ONLY A PERSON WHO IS A CITIZEN OF THE
8 UNITED STATES, WHO IS EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AND WHO
9 IS A QUALIFIED REGISTERED VOTER AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW
10 MAY VOTE IN AN ELECTION IN THIS STATE. A PERSON MAY NOT VOTE
11 FOR MORE CANDIDATES FOR AN OFFICE THAN THE NUMBER OF OFFICES
12 TO BE FILLED AND THAT VOTE SHALL BE THE SOLE MEANS OF
13 DETERMINING THE OUTCOME OF AN ELECTION FOR PUBLIC OFFICE THAT
14 IS REQUIRED UNDER FEDERAL OR STATE LAW.

15 B. All elections by the people shall be by ballot, or
16 by such other method as may be prescribed by law; Provided,
17 that secrecy in voting shall be preserved.

18 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
19 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
20 Constitution of Arizona.
