A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

RATIFYING THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES;  
PROVIDING EQUAL RIGHTS FOR MEN AND WOMEN.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2       Whereas, the Congress of the United States, on March 22, 1972, in  
3 both houses, by a constitutional majority of two-thirds in both houses,  
4 adopted the following proposition to amend the Constitution of the United  
5 States in the following words, to wit:

6                               HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 208

7       Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United  
8 States relative to equal rights for men and women.

9       Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the  
10 United States of America in Congress assembled (two-thirds of  
11 each House concurring therein), That the following article is  
12 proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United  
13 States, which shall be valid to all intents and purposes as  
14 part of the Constitution when ratified by the legislatures of  
15 three-fourths of the several States within seven years from  
16 the date of its submission by the Congress:

17                               ARTICLE —

18               Section 1. Equality of rights under the law shall not  
19 be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on  
20 account of sex.

21               Section 2. The Congress shall have the power to  
22 enforce, by appropriate legislation, the provisions of this  
23 article.

24               Section 3. This amendment shall take effect two years  
25 after the date of ratification.

26 Therefore

27 Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

28       1. That this proposed amendment to the Constitution of the United  
29 States is ratified.

30       2. That the Secretary of State of the State of Arizona transmit a  
31 copy of this Resolution to the President of the United States Senate and  
32 the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives.
