A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE XIII, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA, BY ADDING SECTION 8; RELATING TO MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Article XIII, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to be amended
4 by adding section 8 as follows if approved by the voters and on
5 proclamation of the Governor:

6 8. Cities; towns; elections

7 SECTION 8. FOR ANY CITY OR TOWN WITH A POPULATION OF
8 MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PERSONS THAT PROVIDES FOR
9 ELECTION OF CITY OR TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERS BY DISTRICT, WARD,
10 PRECINCT OR OTHER GEOGRAPHIC DESIGNATION, ONLY THOSE VOTERS
11 WHO ARE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE DISTRICT, WARD, PRECINCT OR
12 OTHER GEOGRAPHIC DESIGNATION, AS APPLICABLE, ARE ELIGIBLE TO
13 VOTE FOR THAT COUNCIL MEMBER CANDIDATE IN THE CITY'S OR TOWN'S
14 PRIMARY, GENERAL, RUNOFF OR OTHER ELECTION.

15 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
16 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
17 Constitution of Arizona.
