**CHAPTER 88**  
**HOUSE BILL 2090**

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 32, CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 32-1129; RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 32, chapter 10, article 2, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 32-1129, to read:

4 32-1129. Apprenticeship programs; certificate of completion;  
5 filing with registrar

6 A. IF A PERSON COMPLETES A UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF  
7 LABOR-APPROVED OR A DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY-APPROVED  
8 APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM IN A CONSTRUCTION TRADE, THE PERSON OR  
9 APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM SPONSOR MAY FILE THE CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION AND  
10 ANY RELATED UPDATES TO THE CERTIFICATE, INCLUDING DOCUMENTATION FOR  
11 COMPLETED CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES, WITH THE REGISTRAR IN A MANNER  
12 PRESCRIBED BY THE REGISTRAR.

13 B. THE REGISTRAR SHALL MAINTAIN ALL DOCUMENTS THAT ARE FILED  
14 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION FOR TEN YEARS.
