HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1357

(Reference to Senate engrossed bill)

1 Page 2, strike lines 2 through 11, insert "self-addressed envelope that complies  
2 with section 16-545, and:

3 1. Through 2025, the instructions shall include the following  
4 statement:

5 In order to be valid and counted, the ballot and mail  
6 affidavit must be delivered to the office of the county  
7 recorder or other officer in charge of elections or may be  
8 deposited at any polling place in the county not later than  
9 7:00 p.m. on election day. The ballot will not be counted  
10 without the voter's signature on the envelope.

11 (WARNING – It is a felony to offer or receive any compensation  
12 for a ballot.)

13 2. Beginning in 2026, the instructions shall include the following  
14 statement:

15 In order to be valid and counted, the mail affidavit that  
16 contains the mail ballot must have the voter's signature on the  
17 envelope and must be returned to the office of the county  
18 recorder by any one of the following methods:

19 (a) Delivering it to the office of the county recorder  
20 or other officer in charge of elections not later than  
21 7:00 p.m. on election day.

22 (b) Depositing it at any polling place in the county not  
23 later than 7:00 p.m. on election day.

1                   (c) Bringing the ballot to any polling place in the  
2                   county not later than 7:00 p.m. on election day and choosing to  
3                   present valid identification that complies with section 16-579,  
4                   subsection A, paragraph 1, Arizona Revised Statutes.  
5                   (WARNING – It is a felony to offer or receive any compensation  
6                   for a ballot.)"
