12           A. The ~~Arizona commerce authority~~ OFFICE OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY  
13 fund is established consisting of:

14           1. Withholding tax revenues allocated to the fund from the job  
15 creation withholdings clearing account pursuant to section 43-409,  
16 subsection B, paragraph 1. Monies credited to the fund may be deposited in  
17 the state treasury or in a bank or other depository approved by the board  
18 of directors pursuant to section 41-1504, subsection D, paragraph 5.

19           2. Monies deposited pursuant to section 18-603.

20           B. The ~~chief executive officer~~ DIRECTOR shall administer the fund.  
21 On notice from the ~~chief executive officer~~ DIRECTOR, the state treasurer  
22 shall invest and divest any monies in the fund deposited in the state  
23 treasury as provided by section 35-313, and monies earned from investment  
24 shall be credited to the fund. Monies in the fund are exempt from the  
25 provisions of section 35-190 relating to lapsing of appropriations.

26           C. The ~~chief executive officer~~ DIRECTOR shall use the monies in the  
27 fund as follows:

28           1. Monies described in subsection A, paragraph 1 of this section  
29 shall be used exclusively for the purposes of this chapter without further  
30 legislative authorization.

31           2. Monies described in subsection A, paragraph 2 of this section  
32 shall be used exclusively for the purposes of title 18, chapter 6."

7           university

8           A. For taxable years beginning from and after December 31, 2014,  
9       before a taxpayer can apply to the department of revenue for certification  
10      of additional income tax credits for increased research activities  
11      involving basic research payments to a university under section 43-1074.01,  
12      subsection A, paragraph 1, subdivision (c) or section 43-1168, subsection  
13      A, paragraph 1, subdivision (d), a taxpayer shall obtain certification from  
14      the authority that the basic research payments meet the requirements of  
15      this section. The taxpayer shall apply to the ~~authority~~ OFFICE for  
16      certification of the basic research payments at a time, on a form and in a  
17      manner prescribed by the ~~authority~~ OFFICE.

18           B. The ~~authority~~ OFFICE shall process and evaluate each application  
19      for certification of basic research payments to a university up to an  
20      amount that corresponds to ~~ten million dollars~~ \$10,000,000 per calendar  
21      year in aggregate combined projected additional tax credits under section  
22      43-1074.01, subsection A, paragraph 1, subdivision (c) and section 43-1168,  
23      subsection A, paragraph 1, subdivision (d). The applicant shall identify  
24      the amount of projected additional tax credits corresponding to the basic  
25      research payments to a university sought to be certified. The amount of  
26      additional tax credits a taxpayer may claim following certification by the  
27      authority must be established by the department of revenue under section  
28      43-1074.01, subsection A, paragraph 1, subdivision (c) or section 43-1168,  
29      subsection A, paragraph 1, subdivision (d). The ~~authority~~ OFFICE shall  
30      process and evaluate applications for certification under this section  
31      through a competitive process pursuant to subsection C of this section that

1 may include third-party peer review. An application for certification must  
2 include:

3       1. The taxpayer's name, address and taxpayer identification number  
4 and a telephone number and e-mail address of a person responsible for the  
5 application.

6       2. A general description of the taxpayer's business and the research  
7 activities contemplated by the taxpayer.

8       3. The amount of the additional income tax credit the taxpayer will  
9 be requesting from the department of revenue.

10      4. Any other information required by the ~~authority~~ OFFICE.

11     C. The ~~authority~~ OFFICE shall establish the time and manner of the  
12 competitive process used in issuing certifications. In determining which  
13 applications must be issued certifications, the ~~authority~~ OFFICE or its  
14 designee shall evaluate among all applicants for certification of basic  
15 research payments, the relative impact of the research activities involving  
16 payments to a university from the standpoint of furthering one or more of  
17 the following considerations:

18       1. Expanding cluster industries. For purposes of this paragraph,  
19 "cluster industries" means concentrations of firms across several  
20 industries that share common economic foundation needs.

21       2. Diversifying and strengthening this state's economy.

22       3. Advancing technological commercialization.

23       4. Enhancing long-term quality job creation.

24       5. Aligning research with university strategic plans.

25     D. Following review of each application pursuant to subsection C of  
26 this section, the ~~authority~~ OFFICE shall either:

27       1. Issue the applicant a letter certifying the basic research  
28 payments.

29       2. Notify the applicant of the denial of the certification with an  
30 explanation of the basis for the denial.

1           E. The ~~authority~~ OFFICE shall adopt rules and prescribe  
2 forms and procedures as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this  
3 section.

4           F. Any information gathered from a business for the purposes of this  
5 section is confidential and may not be disclosed to the public except that  
6 the information must be transmitted to the department of revenue."

19           A. The office of economic opportunity is established.

20           B. The director is responsible for the direction, operation and  
21 control of the office.

22           C. The governor shall appoint the director of the office pursuant to  
23 section 38-211 ~~to serve at the pleasure of the governor~~ FROM A LIST OF  
24 THREE QUALIFIED PERSONS SUBMITTED JOINTLY TO THE GOVERNOR BY THE PRESIDENT  
25 OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. THE DIRECTOR  
26 SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE OFFICE PURSUANT TO  
27 SECTION 41-1502 UNDER THE TERMS OF A PERFORMANCE-BASED CONTRACT.

28           D. The office of economic opportunity operations fund is established  
29 consisting of monies deposited pursuant to sections 44-1843, 44-1861,  
30 44-1892, 44-3324 and 44-3325 and as otherwise provided by law. The office  
31 shall administer the fund. Monies in the fund are continuously

1 appropriated. Monies in the fund may be used in the furtherance of the  
2 mission of the office and related economic development interests.

3 E. The economic development fund is established consisting of monies  
4 received from the Arizona industrial development authority and the Arizona  
5 finance authority as otherwise provided by law. The office shall  
6 administer the fund.

7 Sec. 20. Section 41-5303, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
8 read:

9 **41-5303. Powers and duties**

10 A. The director shall:

11 1. Monitor this state's tax and regulatory competitiveness by  
12 benchmarking this state against competitor states and municipalities,  
13 including implementing a systematic data collection and analysis process to  
14 evaluate tax and regulatory costs to businesses imposed by this state and  
15 municipalities of this state in relation to other states and  
16 municipalities.

17 2. Serve as this state's workforce planning coordinator, provide  
18 staffing support to the workforce Arizona council, provide stewardship of  
19 the state workforce data evaluation system, provide economic and  
20 demographic research and analysis, including constitutionally required  
21 population estimates, provide employment and unemployment estimates and  
22 develop labor market information for the development of the state workforce  
23 strategy.

24 3. Provide office and meeting space, administrative support and  
25 analytical support to the Arizona finance authority and coordinate with the  
26 Arizona finance authority director to incorporate finance market  
27 intelligence in economic development strategy and policy recommendations.

28 4. Develop data-informed policy and regulatory reform  
29 recommendations and provide assistance with state tax and regulatory  
30 matters, including the development and analysis of proposed rules and  
31 regulations and the projected cost on employers relating to those rules and  
32 regulations.

1       5. Provide analytical support ~~to the Arizona commerce authority in~~  
2 ~~its~~ PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 10 OF THIS TITLE REGARDING business recruitment,  
3 growth and retention strategies.

4       6. Provide analytical support to ~~the Arizona commerce authority~~, the  
5 Arizona-Mexico commission in the governor's office, ~~and~~ the office of  
6 tourism ~~in their~~ AND PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 10 OF THIS TITLE REGARDING state  
7 marketing strategies.

8       7. MANAGE, ADMINISTER AND SUPERVISE THE ACTIVITIES OF THE OFFICE  
9 PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 10 OF THIS TITLE.

10      8. NEGOTIATE, MAKE, EXECUTE, ACKNOWLEDGE AND PERFORM CONTRACTS AND  
11 OTHER AGREEMENTS IN THE INTEREST OF THE OFFICE OR TO CARRY OUT OR  
12 ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 10 OF THIS TITLE.

13      B. The director may:

14       1. Contract and incur obligations that are reasonably necessary or  
15 desirable within the general scope of the office's activities and  
16 operations to enable the office to adequately perform its duties.

17       2. Use monies, facilities or services to provide matching  
18 contributions under federal or other programs that further the objectives  
19 and programs of the office.

20       3. Accept gifts, grants, matching monies or direct payments from  
21 public or private agencies or private persons and enterprises for the  
22 conduct of programs that are consistent with the general purposes and  
23 objectives of this chapter."
