AMENDING SECTION 36-2153.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO  
ABORTION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Section 36-2153.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended  
3 to read:  
4 36-2153.01. Website information; agencies providing support  
5 for pregnant women; adoption information  
6 A. On or before ~~February 1, 2022~~ DECEMBER 1, 2025, the department  
7 of health services AND THE ARIZONA HEALTH CARE COST CONTAINMENT SYSTEM  
8 shall provide on the ~~department's~~ public website home page FOR EACH AGENCY  
9 a conspicuous link that directs an individual to the following easily  
10 comprehensible information, in both English and Spanish:  
11 1. A list of public and private agencies and services available to  
12 assist a woman through pregnancy, on childbirth and while her child is  
13 dependent. Any agency that counsels, refers, performs, induces,  
14 prescribes or provides any means for abortion may not be included on the  
15 list.  
16 2. Each agency's services, physical address, telephone number and  
17 website address, if available.  
18 3. Information on and a link to a separate featured webpage that is  
19 accessible by redirecting from the domain name AdoptionOption.AZ.gov and  
20 that lists all of the following:  
21 (a) Public and nonprofit adoption agencies that are not affiliated  
22 with an abortion provider and that are arranged geographically. The link  
23 shall include the information specified in paragraph 2 of this subsection.  
24 (b) Easily comprehensible first steps to assist a pregnant woman  
25 seeking to confidentially explore the option of placing her child for  
26 adoption.  
27 (c) Whether the adoption agency allows the woman to choose the  
28 adoptive parents.  
29 (d) Agencies that offer obstetric ultrasounds free of charge.  
30 (e) Agencies that offer confidential counseling free of charge to a  
31 woman considering placing her child for adoption.  
32 B. All information provided pursuant to subsection A of this  
33 section shall be available in an easily downloadable printed format.
