AMENDING TITLE 32, CHAPTER 32, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 32-3230.02; AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 1,
ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 36-420.06; RELATING TO HEALTH
CARE SERVICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 32, chapter 32, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 32-3230.02, to read:

4 32-3230.02. Vaccination status; unprofessional conduct

5 IT IS AN ACT OF UNPROFESSIONAL CONDUCT FOR A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL TO
6 DENY HEALTH CARE OR TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE THAT IS LESS THAN THE STANDARD
7 OF CARE TO A PERSON BASED ON THE PERSON'S VACCINATION STATUS.

8 Sec. 2. Title 36, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
9 is amended by adding section 36-420.06, to read:

10 36-420.06. Health care institutions; vaccination status;
11 discriminatory policies; prohibition

12 A HEALTH CARE INSTITUTION MAY NOT ADOPT A POLICY THAT ALLOWS A
13 HEALTH PROFESSIONAL TO DENY HEALTH CARE OR TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE THAT IS
14 LESS THAN THE STANDARD OF CARE TO A PERSON BASED ON THE PERSON'S
15 VACCINATION STATUS.
