AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 20, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 7, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 20-1511; RELATING TO FIRE INSURANCE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 20, chapter 6, article 7, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 20-1511, to read:

4 20-1511. State of emergency; fire insurance; cancellation
5 prohibition

6 IF THE GOVERNOR DECLARES A STATE OF EMERGENCY AS PRESCRIBED IN
7 SECTION 26-303 AFTER A NATURAL DISASTER OR WILDFIRE, AN INSURANCE PRODUCER
8 MAY NOT CANCEL OR REFUSE TO RENEW, FOR THE NEXT TWENTY-FOUR MONTHS, A FIRE
9 INSURANCE POLICY WITH AN INSURED WHO RESIDES OR THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN A
10 FIVE MILE RADIUS OF THE NATURAL DISASTER OR WILDFIRE.
