A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE IV, PART 2, SECTION 6, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
2 the Senate concurring:
3 1. Article IV, part 2, section 6, Constitution of Arizona, is
4 proposed to be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on
5 proclamation of the Governor:
6 6. Privilege from arrest; civil process
7 Section 6. Members of the legislature shall be
8 privileged from arrest in all cases except treason, felony,
9 ~~and~~ breach of the peace **AND ALL TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS**, and ~~they~~
10 ~~shall~~ **MEMBERS ARE** not ~~be~~ subject to any civil process during
11 the session of the legislature, ~~nor~~ **OR** for fifteen days ~~next~~
12 before the commencement of each session.
13 2. **The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the**
14 **voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,**
15 **Constitution of Arizona.**
