Description

This bill would modify the definition of physician to include naturopathic physicians for the purposes of AHCCCS coverage.

Estimated Impact

We estimate that the bill's provisions would increase General Fund costs by \$100,000 and Total Funds costs by \$500,000 annually. This estimate is based on a prior year actuarial analysis provided by AHCCCS.

AHCCCS has not provided an updated estimate.

Analysis

AHCCCS's 2024 analysis assumed that the naturopathic doctor (ND) per office cost would be comparable to that of a doctor of medicine (MD) or doctor of osteopathic medicine (DO). However, AHCCCS believed a cost would be generated based on the number of duplicative follow-up visits to an MD/DO for a prescription as a naturopath cannot write such an order.

AHCCCS's estimate assumed that 27 NDs would secure a managed care contract, and that 33.2% of the ND patient panel (or ~19,000 members) would be Medicaid enrollees, each visiting an ND twice per year. AHCCCS projected that of the 38,000 ND visits, 20% of visits would require a follow-up visit to an MD or DO for a prescription. Using the current fee-forservice rate for office outpatient visits (\$67.60), this would result in an annual cost of \$100,000 General Fund/\$500,000 Total Funds.

The change would not become effective unless AHCCCS obtains approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services by October 1, 2028.
