HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1061

(Reference to Senate engrossed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 41-1104, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 41-1104. Travel reimbursement and subsistence for members of
5 legislature; claim required

6 A. Notwithstanding section ~~38-624~~ 38-623, each member of the
7 legislature shall be reimbursed for travel at the federal mileage
8 reimbursement rate as determined annually by the United States general
9 services administration, and such reimbursement shall include travel from
10 the temporary or permanent residence of the member to the state capitol.

11 B. Each member of the legislature shall be paid for each day of
12 subsistence during a regular or special session and for each day of
13 subsistence when the member acts on a legislative matter, other than in a
14 regular or special session, on the prior approval of the presiding officer
15 of the house of which that member is a member in an amount as follows:

16 1. For a member whose permanent residence is within Maricopa county,
17 ~~\$35~~ EIGHTY PERCENT OF THE AMOUNT DETERMINED ANNUALLY BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE
18 DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS SUBSECTION.

19 2. For a member whose permanent residence is outside Maricopa
20 county, one hundred percent of the average of the six highest months of the
21 annual federal per diem rate for Maricopa county, including lodging, as
22 determined by the United States general services administration. The
23 director of the department of administration shall determine this amount
24 annually.

1 C. Subsistence allowed to each member of the legislature during the
2 regular session as provided in subsection B of this section shall be
3 limited to the first one hundred twenty days of a regular session. After
4 the first one hundred twenty days of a regular session, each member of the
5 legislature whose permanent residence is within Maricopa county shall ~~be~~
6 ~~paid the sum of \$10 for subsistence~~ RECEIVE FORTY PERCENT OF THE AMOUNT
7 DETERMINED ANNUALLY BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION
8 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION B, PARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS SECTION for each day of the
9 regular session beyond the first one hundred twenty days AS SUBSISTENCE.
10 Each member whose permanent residence is outside of Maricopa county shall
11 receive fifty percent of the amount determined annually by the director of
12 the department of administration pursuant to subsection B, PARAGRAPH 2 of
13 this section for each day beyond the first one hundred twenty days of a
14 regular session as subsistence.

15 D. Each member of the legislature may elect to opt out of receiving
16 subsistence payments prescribed by subsections B and C of this section.

17 E. Each member of the legislature, for authorized travel out of
18 state, shall receive travel and subsistence expenses as prescribed by law
19 for state officers.

20 F. For payment of travel expenses and subsistence, as prescribed by
21 the terms of this section, each member of the legislature shall submit a
22 claim for travel expenses and subsistence that is countersigned by the
23 presiding officer of the respective body."
