HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1164

(Reference to Senate engrossed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1,
3 section 1, Constitution of Arizona, section 15-1803, Arizona Revised
4 Statutes, is amended to read:

5 15-1803. Alien in-state student status; nonresident tuition
6 exemption

7 A. An alien is entitled to classification as an in-state refugee
8 student if the person has been granted refugee status in accordance with
9 all applicable laws of the United States and has met all other requirements
10 for domicile.

11 B. Notwithstanding any other law, a student, other than a
12 nonimmigrant alien as described in 8 United States Code section
13 1101(a)(15), who meets both of the following requirements is eligible for
14 in-state tuition at any university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona
15 board of regents or at any community college as defined in section 15-1401:

16 1. Attended ~~any~~ OR IS ATTENDING A public or private high school
17 option or homeschool equivalent pursuant to section 15-802 while physically
18 present in this state for at least two years.

19 2. Graduated from any public or private high school option or
20 homeschool equivalent pursuant to section 15-802 while physically present
21 in this state or obtained a high school equivalency diploma in this state.

22 C. Persons without lawful immigration status are eligible for
23 in-state tuition pursuant to subsection B of this section.

1 Sec. 2. Requirements for enactment; three-fourths vote
2 Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona,
3 section 15-1803, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act, is
4 effective only on the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the
5 members of each house of the legislature."
