SENATE AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2172

(Reference to House engrossed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Title 8, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding section 8-469.03, to read:

4 8-469.03. Child sex trafficking; crimes against children;  
5 group homes; training

6 A. THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SAFETY SHALL DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN A  
7 WEBPAGE FOR GROUP HOME TRAINING PROGRAMS AND RESOURCES THAT INCLUDES BOTH  
8 OF THE FOLLOWING:

9 1. AT LEAST ONE TRAINING PROGRAM THAT IS PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE AND  
10 THAT INCLUDES INSTRUCTION ON PREVENTING CHILD SEX TRAFFICKING AND INTERNET  
11 CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN. IF AVAILABLE, THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SAFETY MAY  
12 USE A TRAINING PROGRAM THAT IS PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE BY THE ARIZONA  
13 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

14 2. EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS AND RESOURCES RELATED TO PREVENTING CHILD  
15 SEX TRAFFICKING AND INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN.

16 B. ALL EMPLOYEES OF A GROUP HOME THAT IS CONTRACTED WITH THE  
17 DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SAFETY SHALL ANNUALLY COMPLETE THE TRAINING PROGRAM  
18 PRESCRIBED BY SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.

19 Sec. 2. Appropriation; department of child safety; exemption

20 A. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the state general fund  
21 in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the department of child safety to develop and  
22 maintain a webpage for group home training programs and resources required  
23 by section 8-469.03, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by this act.

24 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt  
25 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating  
26 to lapsing of appropriations."
