Biasiucci, Gillette, and Borrelli Urge Corporation Commission and UniSource Energy to Provide Relief to Residents of Legislative District 30

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX – House Majority Leader Leo Biasucci, Representative John Gillette, and Senator Sonny Borrelli are urging the Chairman of the Arizona Corporation Commission to reconsider his decision to deny the re-opening of discussions on seasonal electricity rates.

In a letter sent today to Commission Chairman Jim O'Connor, the District 30 lawmakers highlighted the significant impact of the new UniSource Energy (UNS) electric rates on residents of Lake Havasu, Kingman, and Golden Valley, particularly those on fixed incomes:

“While we appreciate the Commission’s effort to stabilize the regulatory environment in Arizona, we also believe the Commission must consider the impacts to residents who are struggling under the new rates, including those who are on fixed incomes and choosing between essential expenses. We are confident UNS Electric will take the necessary steps to ensure residents are provided information, but we are concerned consumer outreach may not be enough.”

The legislators requested an opportunity to meet with the Commission and UNS to present examples of constituent bills and further discuss potential solutions.

After submitting the letter to the ACC, House Majority Leader Biasucci stated, “**The residents of Mohave County deserve relief.
