House International Trade Committee Welcomes Indonesian Delegation to Capitol

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX – State Representative Justin Wilmeth, Vice Chairman of the House International Trade Committee, alongside Speaker Ben Toma, Majority Leader Leo Biasiucci, and committee members, welcomed a foreign delegation from the Republic of Indonesia to the Arizona State Capitol today. The 12-member delegation, consisting of elected officials, government representatives, and business leaders, was led by Rahayu Saraswati Dhirakanya Djojohadikusumo, a recently elected member of the People’s Representative Council, Indonesia’s House of Representatives, and the Deputy Chairperson of the Great Indonesia Movement Party (GERINDRA).

In alignment with the Committee’s 2024 International Trade Plan, Vice Chairman Wilmeth, committee members, and the Indonesian delegation met to discuss trade and investment opportunities. Indonesia is among the partner countries the Committee is evaluating to expand and enhance business-to-business and government-to-government relations.
