

We will reduce taxes when possible, cut regulations, make home ownership affordable, and ban foreign adversaries hostile to our interests.




To unleash economic prosperity in Arizona we will endeavor to:

- 1. Promote policies to lower living costs and increase access to affordable goods, housing, energy, and resources for all.
- 2. Defend Arizona's low-tax, light-regulation environment to keep family earnings intact.
- 3. Eliminate taxes on tips for tipped employees.
- 4. Make housing affordable by expediting land development and permit reviews.
- 5. Curb executive overreach and require legislative approval for costly regulations.
- 6. Streamline air permitting to reduce costs and provide regulatory certainty for businesses.
- 7. Support mining, agriculture, and energy industries to ensure affordable power, secure food, and abundant minerals.
- 8. Reform permitting processes and counter excessive regulation that impedes development.
- 9. Protect private property rights and the economic use of land and resources.
- 10. Secure Arizona's water resources for future needs.
- 11. Prioritize Arizonans in land ownership over foreign adversaries.
- 12. Streamline services and reduce burdens for veterans and servicemembers.

IMPROVE EDUCATION

Arizona will continue leading the nation in putting kids and families first in education. The State of Arizona has an obligation to fund the K-12 education of every student as directed by his or her parents. Student achievement is the ultimate goal, not bureaucratic processes. Arizonans strongly support school choice. We will protect education freedom, fund students not systems, shift spending from the bureaucracy to the classroom, take politics out of our classrooms, and increase transparency in public education for parents, students, and taxpayers alike.



To make education better in Arizona we will work to:

- 1. Promote school choice and defend Empowerment Scholarship Accounts.
- 2. Remove divisive "woke" politics from classrooms, restoring respect and empowering parents.
- 3. Increase teacher pay by prioritizing classroom funding over bureaucracy.
- 4. Improve school safety with flexible state resources for law enforcement and campus upgrades.
- 5. Ensure transparency in school board elections, finances, and resource management.
- 6. Foster focused, productive learning environments during instructional hours.
- 7. Eliminate Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion programs in public higher education and promote intellectual diversity.
- 8. Enhance transparency in foreign investments in Arizona's higher education system.
- 9. Protect free speech on college campuses.



SECURE THE BORDER AND SUPPORT LAW ENFORCEMENT

Border security is community safety. We will ensure that our law enforcement agencies have the resources they need to protect Arizonans and that no arm of government obstructs efforts to arrest and deport illegal aliens, especially drug and human traffickers. Arizonans want an end to fentanyl poisonings and sex trafficking. They want to see high-speed pursuits of cars carrying drugs and illegal aliens end. We stand for the rule of law and our work in the Arizona House will reflect that principle.



To secure the border and protect Arizona's communities we will:


- 1. Support implementation of Arizona's Secure the Border Act (Proposition 314), which has overwhelming public support, and ensure that law enforcement has every resource necessary to enforce criminal penalties against people who unlawfully enter this country.
- 2. Support implementation of the Property Tax Refund for Non-Enforcement of Public Nuisance Laws Measure (Proposition 312) to ensure local accountability for enforcing public nuisance and camping laws.
- 3. Strengthen the sanctuary city ban with active local and federal immigration compliance.
- 4. Coordinate statewide law enforcement with federal efforts to fight fentanyl and trafficking.
- 5. Invest in law enforcement to improve recruitment and retention.
- 6. Audit state agencies that contract for refugee services for compliance with state and federal laws.

SECURE ELECTIONS

Arizona voters deserve elections that are free, fair, and transparent. It shouldn't take weeks to count ballots. We will protect the integrity of Arizona elections from anyone who chooses to tamper with them, and we will ensure that ballots are counted faster and results are known sooner.





To secure Arizona elections we will work to:

- 1. Ensure fast, accurate ballot counting for timely election results.
- 2. Require proper ID for in-person voting.
- 3. Secure mail-in ballots and ban unmonitored drop boxes.
- 4. Prohibit foreign funding in campaigns and ballot initiatives.
- 5. Prevent ranked-choice voting schemes to streamline ballot counting.

GOVERNMENT THAT WORKS

Governments derive their power from the people, not the other way around. We will seek out and eliminate waste, fraud, and abuse in government agencies and programs, cut government red tape, and eliminate unnecessary government spending when possible. We work for the people.






To reduce the size, scope, and cost of Arizona government we will strive to:

- 1. Eliminate waste, fraud, and abuse in government programs.
- 2. Curb excessive spending and improve budgeting to combat inflation.
- 3. Streamline government by cutting redundant positions and leveraging technology.
- 4. Remove wasteful programs and Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion mandates from government.
- 5. Require a 60% supermajority of any government body to pass a tax increase.
- 6. Require public universities to disclose foreign investments and ban harmful partnerships with adversaries.




PROTECT INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS AND LIBERTIES

Arizona believes in the dignity of work and self-sufficiency. Social safety net programs must foster that sense of dignity and help put people back on their feet, reducing long-term dependence on other taxpayers for financial needs. A job is more than income, it's a sense of independence, personal responsibility, self-worth, and above all hope in the future. Under our leadership we will focus Arizona's welfare and unemployment programs on empowering people to enter the workforce and start a new chapter of opportunity in their life.



To protect individual rights and liberties in Arizona we will work to:

- 1. Protect the right to work and pursue any career or profession.
- 2. Require able-bodied welfare recipients to work, train, or volunteer in order to receive benefits.
- 3. Adjust unemployment benefits based on the job market.
- 4. Reform licensing and cut regulations to encourage entrepreneurship and innovation.
- 5. Defend parental rights.
- 6. Protect medical freedoms.



Results for this poll were collected using a sampling frame from an online panel collected by the Center for Excellence in Polling. The statewide sample is of 475 likely Arizona voters.

The survey was conducted December 3-6, 2024. The margin of sampling error is \pm 4.50% percentage points. The margin of sampling error may be higher for subgroups. Results presented may not always appear to total 100 percent due to rounding.

Data were post-stratified using weighted demographic information from the U.S. Census Bureau's Current Population Survey Voting and Registration Supplement and the state election authorities. Demographic information for actual voters in past elections was used to construct sample target weights.
